HOW TO BRING A NEW CAT INTO YOUR HOME

1. Keep the new cat quarantined in a "sanctuary room" for the first days or week. Don't allow your old cat into the room.
2. After several days introduce only the "smell" at first by rubbing your cat with a sock and letting the other one smell it. Let the cats smell the sock for several more days.
3. Introduce the new cat to the house and let it explore while the old cat is shut in a separate room. Afterwards let the old cat explore the house and smell the new cats smell.
4. Let the cats have a visual meeting and try to do it in a way that the old cats thinks they found the new cat on its own. Praise your old cat and give it a treat.
5. After several weeks start to have short supervised meetings with both cats in the same room. Make sure to praise the older cat

so it does not feel threatened by the new one. Remember - TAKE IT SLOW.
